Application were invited under many categories like Animal Rescue, Habitat Conservation, Social awareness etc. .The department received 20 application from Amravati, Dhamnagaon, Bandera, Chimur and many nearby places. The Aranya Sakha Award received a great appreciation from the faculty members of other colleges as well, they too expressed that this was much needed to take note of such students who are doing such noble work. There were some suggestion too from the faculty members which the department promised to include in the next year. Department of Zoology at Vinayak Vidnyan Mahavidyalaya, Nandgaon (kh) recently inaugurated the week-long celebration of Birds Week program .Government of Maharashtra has declared 5th to 12th November to be celebrated as Birds week to commemorate the Birth anniversary of two great Ornithologist, Dr Maruti Chitampalli, a well-known Bird expert from Maharashtra and Dr Salim Ali, an Ornithologist of a Global fame. It's very relevant to celebrate this week from 5th to 12th November as this dates are birth anniversary of Dr Maruti Chitampalli and Dr Salim Ali respectively. "MaharashtraPakshiMitraSanghatan" along with many other Non-Governmental Organisation took great efforts to convey the importance and significance of birds' conservation and it was their consistent follow up that resulted in the declaration of the Birds week from 5th to 12th November. This is first time in Maharashtra that Schools, colleges and many other educational Institutes are celebrating the birds Week. The avian Diversity in Maharashtra and other regions are under a huge anthropological pressure as states like Maharashtra, Andra-Pradesh, Telangana, Karnataka and many more are constantly growing industrially while urbanisation is also one of the prime concern of this

In recent year Maharashtra alone has witness the huge decline in Great Indian Bustard, a grass land Bird from area in and around Nannaj in the district of solapur, Maharashtra.Its High time we must start to show some consideration to our wild counterparts. Vinayak Vidnyan Mahavidyalaya, being a pioneer institute took the event to a different height and created an opportunity for the students to get aware towards the most covert of all the birds, the owls. There have been many myths and facts associated with this mystical bird, hence it's more appropriate to start an awareness campaign from this bird. Dr Jayant Wadatkar, President of Maharashtra Pakshimitrasanghatan, is an well-known authority on owls study. His extensive work on the habit-habitat of forest owlet makes him an reliable source of first-hand information. The department thus invited Dr Jayant Wadatkar to deliver a talk on this bird. The Birds Week event gave the department an motivation to conduct this talk, which was otherwise in the pipeline .The event was chaired by President of the event Dr Alka Bhise, Principal Vinayak Vidnyan Mahavidyalaya, Nandgaon (kh). 







3) Wild Glory 04: An innovative National level flower Exhibition & Competition




Report:




