1- To discuss about the planning of Voter Public Awareness & election process program & rally.






It was decided that to create awareness among the citizens and student's importance voting a public rally was organized in the first week of 25th January 2020. It was decided unanimously.


Agenda 2- Regarding the management of the program & rally.


