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#### **ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

- 1) Application on the prescribed form must be accompanied by one recent pass-port size photograph and documents as mentioned.
- 2) The programme for admission for the current year shall be displayed on the notice board.
- Applicants are advised to keep themselves informed of the various notices that are displayed on the Notice Board from time to time.
- 4) Admissions are subject to the eligibility norms of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education & Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati.
- 5) No application will be considered unless it fulfills the following conditions :
  - a) Properly and correctly filled and signed by the applicant & applicant's father / guardian.
  - b) Received by the college office on or before the last date prescribed.
  - c) Accompanied by copies of the following documents duly attested by a Gazetted Officer or an approved teacher of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University.
    - i) School/ College Leaving Certificate (T C.).
    - ii) Statement of marks of the last examination passed/ failed.
    - iii) Migration Certificate in case of a person who has passed the last examination from the Board other than

Maharashtra State Board or the University other than Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University.

- d) Two self addressed post cards should be attached along with the application form.
- e) Student should be fill the affidavit of anti-ragging on http://antiragging.in and submit the hard copy at the time of admission
- 6) Students who pass the qualifying examination from any other Board / University and desire to seek

admission should submit an eligibility certificate.

### **IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS**

- **1.** Attendance: 75% of attendance is compulsory for all students. Students who fall short of attendance will not be allowed to appear for the university examination.
- **2.** College Examination: Unit Test, Class Test and annual preliminary examination will be held at the college . The attendance for this is compulsory. Students remaining absent will be fined.
- **3. Identity Card:**Identity Card will be issued to students and they should take signature of Principal within 15 days from the date of admission. It is mandatory on the part of the students to carry their identity card. If in case the I card is found missing, the student will not be allowed to enter the college premises. If the I- card is lost a duplicate I card will be issued on a payment of Rs. 50/- . Students should carry their Identity Cards daily in the campus.
- 4. Common Fine: Common fine will be imposed on the class if the class furniture and college property is found damaged.
- 5. Cycle Stand & Security Services: At the time of admission, students will have to pay 150/- as cycle stand & security fee. College will not be responsible if the vehicles are not properly locked.
- 6. The fee structure mentioned in the prospectus should be strictly followed. All college fees should be paid before submitting the university examination form.
- 7. Smoking, Gutka chewing and ragging are strictly prohibited in the campus. Offenders shall be liable to face legal action.
- 8. Students should keep campus clean and maintain discipline in the campus.

#### **Prohibition of Ragging Act:**

According to Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act, No. 33, 15th May 1999, Ragging is strictly prohibited. Ragging means a display of disorderly conduct, the doing of any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raise the apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment in a student in any educational institute. Ragging within or outside of any educational institute is prohibited.

**Penalty for Ragging:** Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years and shall also be liable to fine which may extend to Rs. 10000/-. and shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such a student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of order of such dismissal in such cases his / her admission shall be terminated from the institution.

**CODE OF CONDUCT:** 1) Students are expected to inculcate a healthy work culture and discipline. 2) Violation of any rule is punishable. 3)Attendance is compulsory for all activities 4) Cost of damages to the institute property (Books, Computers, Furniture, Tube Lights etc.) is recoverable from the guilty. 5) Misbehavior or misconduct attracts punishment. 6) Mobiles are prohibited in college campus.



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


