On On 9th and 10th August 2021, a two day workshop was organized by Mathematics Department, Vinayak Science College, Nandgaon Khandeshwar. The first session of the first day of this workshop was conducted by Dr. Prachi Agarwal, Head of Department, Department of Mathematics, Brijlal Seed Science College, Amravati was the main guide. He guided the students on "Logic and Paradoxes" through his guidance. Through his guidance, he helped the students understand the examples of world-renowned paradoxes.

Does maths really appear in nature?

In a word, yes.
However, unless you know what to look out for, it isn't very easy to spot.

For example, would you have thought that the breeding of rabbits could be modelled on a simple number sequence?

But that this same sequence can be used to construct the spiral shape that we see on a sea shell?

In this presentation I aim to show some examples of the many different cases where you can find maths in the real world.

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SYMMETRY

Symmetry is everywhere you look in Nature

Symmetry is when a figure has two sides that are mirror images of one another. It would then be possible to draw a line through a picture of the object and along either side the image would look exactly the same - this line would be called a line of symmetry.

There are two kinds of symmetry

One is **Bilateral Symmetry** in which an object has two sides that are mirror images of each other.

The other kind of symmetry is **Radial Symmetry**. This is where there is a center point and numerous lines of symmetry could be drawn.

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Bilateral Symmetry

The human body would be an excellent example of a living being that has Bilateral Symmetry.

Here are some pictures in nature showing bilateral symmetry.

Rabbit multiplication

The breeding of rabbits is a very effective way of demonstrating the Fibonacci sequence.

The Fibonacci sequence is a sequence of numbers formed by adding together the 2 previous numbers.

The Fibonacci sequence starts as follows: 1, 1, 2, 3, 5, 8, 13, 21, 34

So how is this relevant to rabbits breeding?

Let's suppose a newly-born pair of rabbits, one male and one female, are put in a field. Rabbits are able to mate at the age of one month, so at the end of its second month of life a female can produce another pair of rabbits. Suppose that our rabbits never die and that the female always produces one new pair (one male and one female) every month.

What would happen?

Fibonacci flowers?

The Fibonacci sequence previously mentioned appears in other cases. The ratio of consecutive numbers in the Fibonacci sequence approaches a number known as the golden ratio, or phi (1.618033989). Phi is often found in nature. A Golden Spiral formed in a manner similar to the Fibonacci spiral can be found by tracing the seedhead of a sunflower from the centre outwards.

So what would happen?

We would end up with the famous Koch snowflake. By just repeating a simple pattern, you can create a snowflake, yet another example of how maths and nature can share a connection.

Are there any more fractals that create natural images? Yes! Over the next few slides are some of the most impressive natural fractals that have been discovered.

यवतमाळ दि. १० ऑगस्ट : गेल्या २४ तासात जिल्ह्यात एक नवीन कोरोना पॉझिटिव्ह रुग्ण आढळून आला तर तीन जण कोरोनामुक्त झाले आहे.

सध्या एकूण व्हीटिव्ह पॉझिटिव्ह रुग्णांची संख्या जिल्ह्यात सात व बाहेरजिल्ह्यात एक अशी एकूण ८ आहे. आतापर्यंत एकूण पॉझिटिव्ह रुग्णांची संख्या ७२८१७ झाली आहे तर बरे झालेल्यांची एकूण संख्या ७१०२२ आहे. जिल्ह्यात कोरोनामुळे एकूण १७८७ मृत्युची नोंद आहे. आज पॉझिटिव्ह आलेला रुग्ण यवतमाळ येथील रहिवासी असून इतर जिल्ह्यात पॉझिटिव्ह आला आहे.
