Report of National webinar on Science and Tecnology to promote sustainable development with women empowerment

Vinayak Vidnyan Mahavidyalaya and Department of Botany and Zoology recently organised a national level webinar on the topic “*Science and Technology to Promote Sustainable Development with Women Empowerment*”, the webinar was sponsored by **Indian Science Congress Association, Amravati Chapter**. The focus of the webinar was to promote the science and technology among the students belonging to the rural area. Vinayak Vidnyan Mahavidyalaya has been proactive from past many years in the field of creating awareness towards the use and implementation of science and technology at the rural level, taking this motivation further the department of Botany and Zoology organised this webinar to spread the word of awareness among the students as well as to the faculty members and research scholars hailing from rural India. The webinar was scheduled on an online zoom meeting platform owing to the pandemic situation and also to involve larger participation on the national scale. The president of the event was Mrs Sulbha S. Khodke the sitting MLA of Amravati and also the president of Pravin Khodke Memorial Trust, Amravati. The webinar was patronised by Dr Vijayalakshmi Saxena, President of Indian Science Congress Association, Kolkata. The event was also blessed by the presence of chief guest, Dr Alka Bhise, Principal Vinayak Vidnyan Mahavidyalaya Nandgaon Khandeshwar. The event was inaugurated by Dr Atul k Bodkhe, Associate professor Department of zoology at JD Patil Sangdulkar Mahavidyalaya, Daryapur. The convenor of the event Dr Suchita Khodke, head department of Botany at Vinayak Vidnyan Mahavidyalaya Nandgaon Khandeshwar introduced the event to the participants as well as to the esteemed guest. She in her introductory speech gave a glimpse of the institutes work towards creating awareness in the field of science and technology, she also mentioned that 70% of the students are girls in the institute hence it becomes our responsibility to make sure that each girls student gets the oppportunity to explore her potential to the fullest. The event was inaugurated by Dr Atul Bodkhe, he in his inaugural speech extended the support and also appreciated the efforts taken by the institute in the past years to promote science at the rural level. The chief guest Dr Alka Bhise mention that although she did not belong to the science field but being a feminist by nature she appreciated the approach and the idea behind organisation of this webinar .She categorically mentioned that a women from past many decades have shown a remarkable improvement in all walks of life. The webinar was conducted in two sessions. In Session one the participant witnessed an enlightening speech by Dr Anupama Harshal she is an consultant at

IISER, Pune, she is also heading the project Manav for UGC HRD. Her topic for the day was How to Read a Scientific literature. The session was made interactive by her constant question to the participants and this made the session livelier. She was introduced to the participants by Mr Shilanand Hiwrale, Assistant professor Department of Botany. Session two was conducted by Mrs Nandini kotharkar, Assistant professor at Fergusson College Pune, she is also the head of innovation and incubation centre at Deccan education society. She in her keynote speech give list of various entrepreneur opportunities available for the women studying basic science, she also named various funding agencies that are helping the women entrepreneur to make a start-up. The participants ask many queries to both the resource person and where satisfactorily answered. The resource persons shared their contacts with the participant so as to make any further enquiries regarding the concern topics. At the end the webinar organised was productive helpful and enlightening for all the participants there were many faculty members also present they attended the webinar and also gave verbal feedback. In all 268 participant registered for the event out of which 100 attended the webinar on zoom platform, while 93 individuals attended the same on the YouTube. The webinar was concluded by Dr Pratibha Mahalle, head dept. of zoology, she delivered the vote of thanks. The event was coordinated by Mr Subodh Bansod, Assistant professor Zoology, also the technical and logistics were coordinated by Dr Prashant Kharat and Mr Ajay Ambhore, dept. of physics.
